This description is designed to create an understanding between Hal-Con and the prospective person to ensure no miscommunication. This is a **NON-COMMITTEE, unpaid volunteer position**.

Role:	COSPLAY HANDLER (NON-COMMITTEE POSITION)
Reports to:	Hal-Con Director of Community Engagement and/or Director of Promotions
General description of role:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This is a non-cosplay/costume position • Helping out with many types of events as needed as a member of the street team. This can include helping to “handle and organize” other cosplayers, stand watch over private belongings of team members, being present at our private space; set up/tear down of the displays, tents, take pictures, be available to assist, etc • In some cases, act as a buffer between the public and cosplayers as needed, assist with line management, or crowd control
Responsibilities	<p>This is a year round position. As a member of the Street team, you will be asked to wear a Hal-Con shirt (provided) at events such as parades, community fairs, or other promotional events for Hal-Con. You will work as a member of the team along with the cosplayers to promote Hal-Con in a positive and safe manner</p> <p>We ask that you attend between a minimum of 10 events per year. These are mainly weekends for a few hours per event.</p> <p>During the convention weekend, unless you wish to sign up as a volunteer for the convention, your time will be your own.</p>
Skills required:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must display patience, kindness, and a sense of “fun” especially in the presence of children • Tech skills are helpful, mostly being able to operate the cameras on many different cell phone models. • You must be a team player and remember while you are at events, you represent Hal-Con and must represent our values. <p>PLEASE NOTE: <i>As a member of the street team and because we will be around and dealing with families and children, we would also ask that you submit to a Child Abuse Registry check as part of the interview process.</i></p>
